MEET CONDITIONS

The Ken Deeley Open Meet is licensed at level 3 by Swim England, for entry into County & Regional Championships. The meet is held under the auspices of Brighton Swimming Club and will be held under Swim England Laws & Technical Rules of swimming.

Competitors must be members of the club they represent and registered as "Club Compete" (Cat 2) with Swim England or the equivalent in the swimmers home association.

The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is Female.

The competition is open to eligible competitors only and entry will be taken, by the promoters, as an undertaking that the swimmer is a bona fide eligible competitor.

Short course (25m pool) entry times are required for all events and must be equal to or slower than the published upper limit times. Ages will be as at the 16th September 2023.

All entries must be on Hytek team manager files available on the club website, or on application and returned by email to openmeets@brightonsc.co.uk

Individual entries from swimmers whose clubs are not entering should be sent on the form provided.

Entry fees are £7.00 for each event & the closing date for all entries is **Midday 1st September 2023.**

In line with licensing regulations, If any session is timed to exceed 3 hours, we will programme a 15 minute break for officials into that session.

If this is necessary, then the timing of this break will be published after the closing date once the number of entries are confirmed.

Should the meet be oversubscribed rejections will be on a slowest time basis with regards to each age group.

NON-COMPETITORS are not permitted on poolside without a coach pass or an Official designation.

Coach Passes cost £20 each and include all pre meet programme information.

Lunch is included with coach passes and is served in the Old slipper baths, Top floor of the building on the left hand side of the entry to the car park.

Coach passes should be ordered with the submission of the entry file and paid for with the entries.

1 pass is recommended per 10 swimmers.

Entry fees & coach pass fees can be paid by Bank Transfer (BACS)

Please wait for confirmation of accepted entries before sending payment The account details will be published on acceptance of entries.

The Gala

- It is the responsibility of each individual to present themselves to the stewards at the correct time
- All races will be swum on a heat declared basis.
- Awards should be collected during the gala with no formal prize giving ceremonies. Awards should be collected as soon as possible following the publication of the event result and will be given to the top 3 swimmers in the following age groups for the advertised events.
- 50m free, 50m back, 50m Breast, 50m Fly & 100m IM for ages 9yrs 10yrs 11yrs 12yrs 13yrs 14yrs & 15/Over
- The boomed end of the main pool will be available as a swim down facility at all times. Any swimmer not behaving correctly will be required to leave the swim down pool.
- Coaches/team managers are responsible for the supervision of their own swimmers at all times.
- Coaches/Team Managers are requested to ensure that their swimmers keep the poolside free of litter.

Clubs should ask their officials who are volunteering for this meet, to contact Martin Spowage officialscoordinator@brightonsc.co.uk to register themselves.

Breakfast, lunch & onsite car parking facilities are provided free for all officials.

Withdrawals on the day should be done as notified and final times for withdrawals are published with the warm up times.

Swimmers are not permitted to leave the poolside/changing areas in swim wear or without having first dried and dressed appropriately, including footwear.

A secondary strobe will be available upon request for S15 category swimmers at this meet.

DATA PROTECTION: Swim meet entries will be managed on a computer. By submitting entries, consent is thereby given as required under GDPR to the holding of personal information on a computer.

Some personal data including submitted and recorded times will be made public before, during & after the meet.

Photographs may be taken at this meet and there may also be a photographer from a news agency with a view to publication to accompany any article concerning the meet. By entering this meet you agree to these photographs being taken & published. Personal photography is also permitted and should adhere to Swim England Wavepower guidelines.

The decision of the referee on all aspects of racing is final. Matters other than those under the control of the referee and not covered by these conditions, shall be decided upon and resolved by Brighton Swimming Club whose decision shall be final.

General Information

Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended. Neither Brighton Swimming Club, nor the Prince Regent Swimming Complex management can be held responsible for lost property.

Only one small bag per person will be allowed onto poolside so it is recommended that all swimmers use the lockers provided at the complex. These require a £1 coin to operate which is refundable.

A swim shop will be in attendance in the foyer.

No programmes will be printed for spectators at this meet. Printed heat sheets will be made available for all coach pass holders. We will have Hytek "Meet mobile" activated on the day, this will give all heat start sheets and results in real time for those who have it downloaded to their mobile device. Printed results will only be posted on poolside during the gala. Anyone wishing to view or print a full set of results, will be able to download these from the club website following the meet completion.

HYtek Team manager result files will also be available on the website or on request from openmeets@brightonsc.co.uk
Results will be available from www.brightonsc.co.uk ASAP following the gala.

Clubs will be allocated a space on poolside in relation to the number of swimmers attending.
A poolside plan will be published in advance as will a form for emailing advance withdrawals.

As the Prince regent car park is small it is restricted to pass holders only.
Passes are only issued to officials.
There are numerous other car parks with easy walking distance of the pool.

Submission of entries to this meet implies full acceptance of all these conditions.
