MEET CONDITIONS

The Ken Deeley Open Meet is licensed at level 3 by Swim England, for entry into Level 1 & 2 open meets & County & Regional Championships. The meet is held under the auspices of the City of Brighton & Hove Swimming Club and will be held under Swim England Laws & Technical Rules of swimming.

Competitors must be members of the club they represent and registered as "Club Compete" (Cat 2) with Swim England or the equivalent in the swimmers home association.

The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy.

By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is Female.

The competition is open to eligible competitors only and entry will be taken, by the promoters, as an undertaking that the swimmer is a bona fide eligible competitor.

Short course (25m pool) entry times are required for all events and must be equal to or slower than the published upper limit times. Ages will be as at the 14th September 2024.

All entries must be on Hytek team manager files as attached to the notification email. The file will also be available on the club website, or on application and returned by email to

openmeets@brightonsc.co.uk

Individual entries from swimmers whose clubs are not entering, must be on the form available on the [club website](#)

Entry fees are £7.00 for each event & the closing date for all entries is **Midday 31st August 2024.**

In line with licensing regulations, If any session is timed to exceed 3 hours, we will programme a 15 minute break for officials into that session.

If this is necessary, then the timing of this break will be published after the closing date once the number of entries are confirmed.

All entries from Co B & H will be accepted and then should the meet be oversubscribed rejections will be on a slowest time basis with regards to each age group.

NON-COMPETITORS are not permitted on poolside without a coach pass or an Official designation.

Coach Passes cost £15 each with lunch included or **£10** without food. These all include Heat start sheets on the day.

Coach passes should be ordered with the submission of the entry file and paid for with the entries.

Swim England has a set of minimum requirements for poolside supervision at galas. All clubs entering should refer to that policy when ordering coach passes.

Entry fees & coach pass fees can be paid by Bank Transfer (BACS)

Please wait for confirmation of accepted entries before sending payment The account details will be published on acceptance of entries.

The Gala

- It is the responsibility of each individual to present themselves to the Marshalls at the correct time
- All races will be swum on a heat declared basis.
- Awards should be collected during the gala with no formal prize giving ceremonies. Awards should be collected as soon as possible following the publication of the event result and will be given to the top 3 swimmers in both Female & Open/Male categories in the following age groups for the advertised events.
- 50m free, 50m back, 50m Breast, 50m Fly & 100m IM for ages 9yrs 10yrs 11yrs 12yrs 13yrs 14yrs & 15/Over
- The boomed end of the main pool will be available as a swim down facility at all times. Any swimmer not behaving correctly will be required to leave the swim down pool.
- Coaches/team managers are responsible for the supervision of their own swimmers at all times.
- Coaches/Team Managers are requested to ensure that their swimmers keep the poolside free of litter.

"All clubs submitting entries are requested to assist in the running of the meet by supplying details of any Licensed officials who are willing to assist at this Gala"

Clubs should ask their officials who are volunteering for this meet, to contact Martin Spowage officialscoordinator@brightonsc.co.uk to register themselves.

Breakfast, lunch & onsite car parking facilities are provided free for all officials.

Withdrawals on the day should be done as notified and final times for withdrawals will be published with the warm up times.

Swimmers are not permitted to leave the poolside/changing areas in swim wear or without having first dried and dressed appropriately, including footwear.

A secondary strobe will be available upon request for S15 category swimmers at this meet.

Swim meet entries will be managed on a computer. By submitting entries, consent is thereby given as required under GDPR to the holding of personal information on a computer.

Some personal data including competitors names, along with submitted and recorded times will be made public before, during & after the meet.

Photographs may be taken at this meet and there may also be professional photographers, including a photographer from a news agency with a view to publication to accompany any article concerning the meet. By entering this meet you agree to these photographs being taken & published. Personal photography is also permitted and should adhere to Swim England Wavepower guidelines. No photography of any type is allowed in the changing areas and mobile phone use is also prohibited in the changing areas.

The decision of the referee on all aspects of racing is final. Matters other than those under the control of the referee and not covered by these conditions, shall be decided upon and resolved by the City of Brighton & Hove Swimming Club whose decision shall be final.

General Information

Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended. Neither City of Brighton & Hove Swimming Club, nor the Prince Regent Swimming Complex management can be held responsible for lost property.

Only one small bag per person will be allowed onto poolside so it is recommended that all swimmers use the lockers provided at the complex. These require a £1 coin to operate which is refundable.

A swim shop will hopefully be in attendance in the foyer.

No programmes will be printed for spectators at this meet. We intend to have Hytek "Meet mobile" activated on the day, this will give all heat start positions and results in real time for those who have it downloaded to their mobile device.

Printed results will only be posted on poolside during the gala. Anyone wishing to view or print a full set of results, will be able to download these from the club website following the meet completion.

Please note that email & website addresses will currently remain as Brightonsc.co.uk.

Hy-Tek Team manager result files will be emailed to the contact given on entry and will also be available on the club website or on request from openmeets@brightonsc.co.uk

Clubs will be allocated a space on poolside in relation to the number of swimmers attending. A poolside plan will be published in advance as will a form for withdrawals on the day.

As the Prince regent car park is small it is restricted to pass holders only.

Passes are only issued to officials.

There are numerous other car parks with easy walking distance of the pool.

Submission of entries to this meet implies full acceptance of all these conditions.
